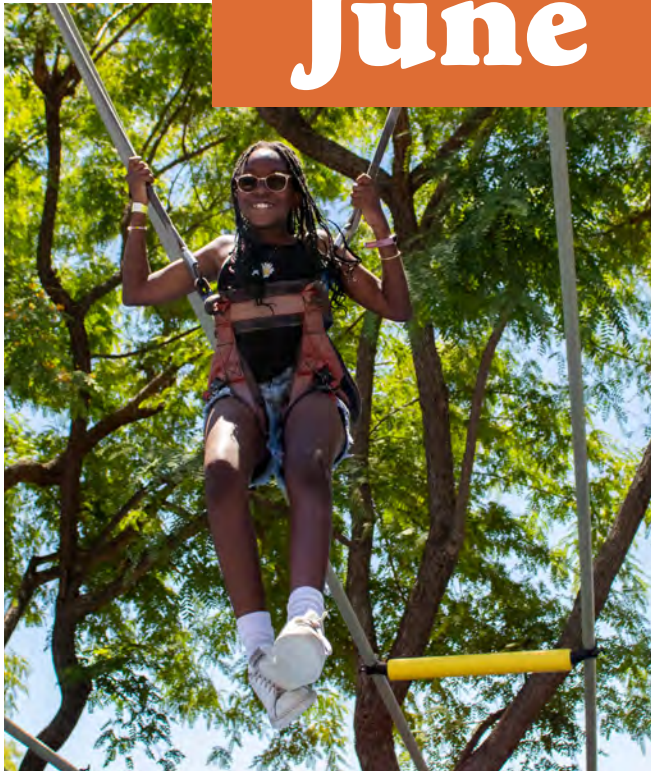

Make Up Days and Schedule Changes

Each camper is allowed two make up days per summer in the event of absences. Please email the admissions office at least 24 hours in advance to schedule your days. Makeup days are not allowed on Wednesdays.

After both make up days have been used, a \$50 schedule change fee will be charged. Please email all schedule changes to camp@sierracanyonschool.org. Please note: ALL programs are non-refundable.

Camp Facts for Parents and Campers

What should my child bring to camp each day?

Your child should bring a swimsuit and towel labeled with your child's first and last names. Swim apparel should be carried in a tote bag with the camper's name on it. A sack lunch, lunch money, or lunch ticket with the camper's name on it should be provided as well as a reusable water bottle. We provide popsicles in the afternoon.

What should my child wear to camp?

Play clothes are the most comfortable. Closed-toed shoes are preferred. Parents are requested to mark their child's first and last names on all belongings! Sierra Canyon is not responsible for lost articles.

How will my child be placed in a group?

Children are grouped according to grade level. All groups are co-ed and are supervised by at least one head counselor, one junior counselor, and two CITs throughout the day. We can only guarantee one friend request.

What is a unit?

Sierra Canyon is divided into two units. Unit 1 consists of children entering PK through 2nd Grade. Unit 2 includes children entering 3rd Grade and above as well as specialty camps. The camp divides into units at the end of the day for closing programs.

What happens the first day of camp?

On the first two days of camp, all campers will meet at the amphitheater at 9:30 a.m. The counselors for each group will be called down along with the campers in their group. As soon as each new group is completed, they will proceed to their "special" area and begin their day. If your child is starting camp at a later date, we have a system that ensures a smooth transition. Once they check into one of our "welcome tables", they will be escorted to their group tables where they will receive a personal orientation with their counselors. We focus on building positive connections so that all our new campers feel right at home the moment they arrive on campus.
